

The Sterling Inn


South Sterling, Pennsylvania



Nestled high in the Pocono Mountains, The Sterling Inn is surrounded by landscaped gardens, lush green lawns and crystal clear meandering stream. This pretty, park-like setting, has been a country retreat for over 100 years providing guests, young and old, with a host of wonderful activities, fine dining and a remarkably friendly experience.

Memories of comfortable summer days and sultry nights rush through your mind when that certain kind of breeze blows through the trees, or the smell of fresh cut grass fills the air. Today, owners Ron and Mary Kay Logan and daughters Genevieve and Bridget, continue to capture the charmed, relaxed graciousness and comfort of times gone by. Known for its fine food and accommodations for over 100 years, the inn started its humble beginnings as the Drovers Wayside stop in 1856, and has grown into the wonderful full service country inn that it is today.

Sixty-five individually decorated rooms and suites offer



comfortable and elegant accommodations in a picturesque setting. All boast beautiful country furnishings and antiques, private bath, and telephone. Many have garden views and some are handicap accessible. There are charming rooms in the Lodge and the Guest House as well as the Main Inn, which also has two Fireplace Suites and one Deluxe Suite with a private living room and cable TV. Ten Country Cottage Suites along the nature trail boast a fireplace, two person jacuzzi, beautiful antique furnishings, a front porch and conveniences such as a refrigerator, microwave and coffeemaker. Victorian and Country Fireplace Suites in the historic Nearbrook and Wayside buildings, are decorated with beautiful antiques and Victorian country furnishings. Each has its own living room, fireplace, cable TV, refrigerator, coffeemaker and private deck overlooking the Wallenpaupack Creek.

There are also several private cottages, four with fireplaces and two with jacuzzi. Restful moments can be found in the small libraries and cozy nooks of the Main Lodge or in the living

room in front of the fireplace. Inspirational walks or explorations in search of picnic spots can be found along miles of walking and hiking trails by the two crystal clear streams, or adjacent to the beautiful waterfall along the mountain path.

Whether you are lounging on the sandy beach or enjoying a bonfire by the lake, these simple activities help to make this the perfect summer retreat.

More adventurous summer activities include paddleboating, fishing, nature programs, swimming in the lake or indoor pool and outdoor tennis, volleyball, badminton and shuffleboard. In Winter, ice-skating, sledding, snow-shoeing, tobogganing and cross-country skiing are just part of the many things to do. Nearby downhill skiing, snow tubing, and horse-drawn sleigh rides are also fun Winter options. During the Summer, golfing, boating, state parks, horseback riding and summer theater can all be found nearby. The all glass enclosed pool offers swimming opportunities year round and, in summer, the doors and top panels open to let in the sunshine and country breezes.

Dining at the Inn is a wonderful experience and The Hearthstone Dining Room offers a variety of menu selections such as Sautéed Tender Veal Medallions served in A Dried Cherry, Sweet Vermouth Balsamic Vinegar Demi-Glace. Overnight rates include a candlelight dinner and full country breakfast. With all this, it is no wonder that generations of families have continued to visit the Sterling Inn year after year.
